Mostly this list contains descendants of Jørgen and his first wife Olava Olsdatter, but we have included all Jørgen's relationships: One relationship with a woman before marrying, and the daughter born thereafter, two marriages, only the first one to Olava resulting in children.

The book on farms at Ørland has only three children born to Jørgen and Olava. Here you can find five children. You can also read a little about where they lived their lives and - of course - their descendants.

Still, this is a list of people with data about them, so if you are looking for the family saga, or the novel about the family, you should look somewhere else.

The list will be updated when new information is found, and you can check this document for the date of the last added information. You will find this information below here.

You will not be able to find much information from recent years here, and of course no information about people living today should be found here. If you need such information, you should try to contact me, Åsmund Solem, since such information certainly is to be retrieved, but I don't want to publish this on the web.

I have tried to make some headlines telling you which family branch you are on, starting with «Line of descent...». I hope this will ease your reading and ability to find what you are looking for in the document.

First Generation: Jørgen and Olava

1. *Jørgen Andreassen Lie* b. 1791, d. 05.15.1874

Born 1791 at the farm Sigstad in Rennebu, South Trøndelag (those days the under-parish «Indset Annex» under the Kvikne parish was part of Hedmark county, then called «Amt»). Son of Andreas Henriksen Sigstad (1748-1820) and Ingrid Eriksdatter Nordland (abt 1754-1838). Christened in the Innset Church 03.27.1791ⁱ, had his confirmation ceremony the same place 07.26.1807ⁱⁱ. Moved to Trondheim to be an apprentice in order to become a blacksmith, and came according to the church records to the farm Austrått, Ørland as a blacksmith in 1820ⁱⁱⁱ. However, if you look below here, something tells us that this information about Jørgen's arrival at Ørland is not quite accurate, and that he came a little bit earlier. It was very often written in the church records years after they actually came to the parish.

Jørgen and his wife also lived some time at the farm Ottersbo the first time after they married. This is the farm next to Austrått.

Jørgen was later a «husmann»¹ with land and a fisherman at the place Bakken under the Viklem farm from the middle of the 1820s. This is the place where Jørgen's grandchild Theodore and his siblings grew up. Jørgen A. L. died 05.15.1874^{iv}.

He had one child with Karen Andersdatter in 1819.

Married 1st time 02.21.1822^v in the Viklem Church to Olava Olsdatter, b. abt 1797, of unknown heritage. Olava died 05.31.1848^{vi}.

Married 2nd time 06.21.1855^{vii} to Kirsten Larsdatter b. 02.28.1799, died 04.26.1895

Second Generation: Jørgen's Children

2a Grete Jørgensdatter b. 07.09.1819

Born 07.09.1819 as the daughter of the servant maid Karen Andersdatter and servant boy and blacksmith Jørgen Andreassen. Christened 08.01.1819 in the church that at the time was called the Viklem Church, and both parents had adress at the Austrått farm at that time (those days written «Østraad» or «Østrodd»).

It has been difficult to find traces of her life, but we find her having her confirmation ceremony 10.25.1835. Adress is then «Hjertsvig», and her place of birth is said to be «Innstrand» (farm name in Ørland).

Married 09.29.1855 in Nærøy parish to Aage Ingebrigtsen, b. 12.10.1823 in Ørland.

2b Andreas Jørgensen Wiklem b. 05.29.1822, d. 11.22.1877

Born 05.29.1822 at Ottersbo, Ørland, South Trøndelag. Christened at the Viklem Church, Ørland 07.16.1822. Had his confirmation ceremony 10.01.1837 at the Viklem Church. Moved according to the church records to Kristiansund in Møre og Romsdal (major town southwest of Ørland) 07.28.1847. Moved to Bakklandet parish in Trondheim 08.12.1853. He was at first a sailor, later a merchant in Trondheim. Died 11.22.1877 at Bakklandet parish in Trondheim.

Married 01.24.1858 in Bakklandet parish, to Sara Petrine Rønning b. 08.14.1821, died 06.22.1908. She had been married before, and had two daughters: 1) Gunelie Henrikka Rønning b. 03.24.1843, married 08.23.1874 in Trondheim to Nils Andreas Kristensen from Sortland, Northern Norway, and 2) Anna Christine Rønning b. abt 1845.

Born at Austrått according to the church records, christened 08.29.1824 in the Viklem Church. Had his confirmation ceremony 1841. Moved abt 1845-46 to Trondheim. Sailor, married 01.03.1858 to Trine Birgitte Hoeggen b. 04.26.1822. Lars only used the patronymic name Jørgensen as a last name. There is no information about children, but Olufine Thoresen (niece) is living in the household in the 1875 census as the foster child of Trine Jørgensen. Lars died 07.07.1872, and was buried 07.12.1872. Trine died 11.02.1887, buried 11.09.1887. Adress from the census of 1865 till Trine's death in 1887 was Batterigaten 3, Vår Frue parish.

2d Elen Jørgensdatter Viklem b. 06.03.1827, d. 10.27.1907

Born 06.03.1827 at Bakken, christened 07.14.1827 at the Viklem Church. Had her confirmation ceremony 10.02.1842 at the Viklem Church. Together with her husband Iver, she took over the place called Bakken. Elen lived some periods in Trondheim at her daughters' her last years, and we find her visiting there in the 1900 census. She died at Bakken though, 10.27.1907, and was buried 11.04.1907.

Married to Iver Thoresen b. 11.23.1820 in Meldal, South Trøndelag, christened 12.17.1820 in Meldal. Moved together with his parents Thore Olsen (1791-1876) and Gurru Iversdatter Løfshus (1790- after 1865) to Lensvik, to a place under the Aarem farm, a place that was later called «Torenesset» («the Tore peninsula»). Iver had his confirmation ceremony in Stadsbygd parish 10.23.1836, and he came to Ørland in 1852 to work at Hovde, to «serve» as they said. Iver died at Bakken 05.09.1895.

All we know of Ole so far, is that he was born at Bakken, christened in the Viklem Church 04.11.1830, and had his confirmation ceremony 10.05.1845.

Born at Bakken, christened 02.16.1833 at the Viklem Church, had her confirmation ceremony the same place 10.03.1847. Moved to Trondheim in 1855. Died after 1900. Her name is also some places written «Anne Kathrine».

Married 1st time to Gullik Toresen b. 04.06.1823 in Stavern, died before 1875. Sailor.

Married 2nd time 07.02.1876 in the «Vår Frue» Church (means «Our Lady») to Odin Valdemar Aas b. 1844, died before 1900.

Born 08.25.1845 in Bjugn, christened 09.30.1845. He was born out of wedlock.
At the census in 1900 he is living at the farm “Val store” in Nærøy.

2a3b Anne Elisabeth Aagesdatter b. 06.11.1856

Born 06.11.1856 in Nærøy, Nord-Trøndelag, christened 09.28.1856 in Nærøy.

2a3c Anton Edvard Aagesen Laugen b. 06.04.1860

Born 06.04.1860 in Nærøy.

2b3a Augusta Marie Wiklem b. 07.05.1852

Born 07.05.1852 at Bakklandet in Trondheim, christened 07.25.1852. We don't know much about her. She is still living in 1875 (census), living at Bakklandet.

2b3b Jørgine Olava Wiklem b. 04.16.1857

Born 04.16.1857 at Bakklandet in Trondheim, christened 06.28.1857. We don't know much about her. She is still living in 1875 (census), living at Bakklandet. She is also to be found the same year in Sortland, visiting her half sister Gunelia Hendrikke Kristensen.

2b3c Ole Peder Wiklem b. 04.14.1860, d. 11.17.1861

Born 04.14.1860 at Bakklandet in Trondheim, christened 05.28.1860, but died already 11.17.1861.

2b3d Sara Alida Oldine Wiklem b. 10.24.1863

She used the name Oldine. Born at Bakklandet in Trondheim 10.24.1863, christened 12.13.1863. She later lived at Møllenberg in Trondheim.

Married 06.04.1892 in Bakklandet parish, Trondheim to Hans Oldus Waade b. 04.16.1861 in Verran, North Trøndelag. Hans worked at «Baklandets Støberi og mek. Værksted» (a mechanical company) as «Modelformand» (foreman for developing models).

2d3a Odin Jørginius Iversen b. 09.22.1853, d. 09.17.1868

Born 09.22.1853, and christened as "uægte" (illegitimate) in the Viklem Church 10.23.1853. At Odin's birth and christening, Iver's address was Hovde, which is the farm he came to work at. As we know, the parents married one year after Odin's birth. Odin Jørginius died 09.17.1868, a few days before he would have been 15 years old, and he was buried 09.23.1868. The church records have no information on the causes of his death.

2d3b Theodore Iversen Wicklem b. 06.22.1855, d. 1912

Born at Bakken 06.22.1855, christened 08.20.1855 as «Theodor». Had his confirmation ceremony 10.30.1870. Emigrated in 1881 to Eau Claire, Wisconsin, USA. Departure from Trondheim 08.25.1881. Theodore Wicklem died as early as 1912 in Eau Claire.

Married 12.05.1885 in Eau Claire to Gunda Halvorsen b. 01.10.1865 in Borge close to the town Fredrikstad, as a daughter of Paul and Sophie Halvorsen. She was christened 04.16.1865 in Borge. The family lived most of their lives in Borge, but they also lived a short period in Orkdal, South Trøndelag, where the father Paul worked for a local businessman called Thams, also from the Fredrikstad area. Both Fredrikstad and Orkdal was then known for lumber industry. The Halvorsen family emigrated to Wisconsin in 1879. Gunda died 02.25.1948. Both Gunda and Theodore are buried at Northside Cemetery in Eau Claire, Wisconsin, and so are many of the other members of the Halvorsen family.

Theodore and Gunda had all in all 8 children, but it hasn't been possible to find those who didn't grow up. The censuses tell us that the number of total children were 8. 5 of them grew up.

She was educated within the making of clothes in Copenhagen. Lived most of her life in Trondheim, and had a business there, making clothes. Died abt 1937.

2d3d Jørgen Iversen b. 01.02.1860, d. 12.17.1939

Born at Bakken 01.02.1860, christened in the Ørland Church 05.06.1860. Died 12.17.1939 at the new home they built, also called Bakken.

Married 11.11.1895 to Ludvika Eilertsdatter Kløften b. 03.08.1862, christened in the Ørland Church 04.20.1862, died 09.17.1955.

Born 03.09.1865 at Bakken, christened 05.25.1865 in the Ørland Church. Had her confirmation ceremony the same place 01.02.1881. Died 02.27.1926 at the farm Rønne, Ørland. Buried 03.06.1926 at Ørland Cemetary.

Olava had one son with Henrik Thans Hoikendorff, b. 1856 in Copenhagen.

Married 01.05.1893 to Elias Brodersen b. 09.30.1864.

Born 1867 at Bakken, christened 05.17.1867 in the Ørland Church, had her confirmation ceremony the same place 10.01.1882. Died 05.30.1939 in Trondheim.

When it comes to date of birth, the church records at christening and confirmation use 04.23.1867. Still there are lots of indications that Eline herself used 03.25.1867 as her date of birth.

Married 12.29.1900 in Nidarosdomen (The Nidaros Cathedral), Trondheim to «seddeltrykker» («seddel» means bills, «trykker» means printer, ie. printer of bills/money) Oskar Ellefsen, b. 02.09.1870 in Trondheim, died 04.18.1905 in Trondheim. Those days the Bank of Norway was in Trondheim, and Oskar was one of those who printed the bills.

No children.

2d3i Odin Iversen b. 03.11.1869, d. 03.24.1892

Born 03.11.1869 at Bakken, christened 05.30.1869 in the Ørland Church, died 03.24.1892 at Bakken, buried 03.31.1892 at Ørland Cemetary.

We don't know much about Odin. I have for instance not found any church record on confirmation at Ørland in the time span that would have been logical.

Born at Bakken 10.10.1896, christened 11.22.1896. She did not reach her confirmation. She died 07.24.1911, and was buried 07.31.1911 at Ørland Cemetary. The church records, this time the «Klokkebok» gives a cause of death, and it is «Hjernetuberkulose» («tuberculosis in the brain»), but it ought to be meningitis.

2d3d4b Inga Idvarda Iversen b. 09.22.1898, d. 01.30.1973

Born at Bakken 09.22.1898, christened 10.30.1898 in the Ørland Church, had her confirmation the same place 06.29.1913. Inga died 01.30.1973.

Married 12.14.1922 in Vår Frue Church, Trondheim to Peter Kristian Hårberg b. 05.24.1892 at the Espenes farm in Rissa, South Trøndelag as son of Isak Olsen Espenes and his wife Anna Petersdatter. Kristian (he did not use the name Peter) grew up at Ørland with his uncle and aunt at a farm called Hårberg. He attended Skjetlein agricultural school, later the agricultural college at Ås near Oslo. Kristian Hårberg died in 1961.

Born at Bakken 03.19.1904, christened 05.01.1904 in the Ørland Church, had her confirmation ceremony the same place 06.29.1919. Jørgine died 06.17.1987, and was buried at the Ørland Cemetary.

Married 1931 to farmer Olaf Solem b. 07.12.1901. Olaf was son of Johan Arnt Solem and Gunhild Olsdatter Rokseth at the farm Viken. Olaf Solem died 01.13.1972
